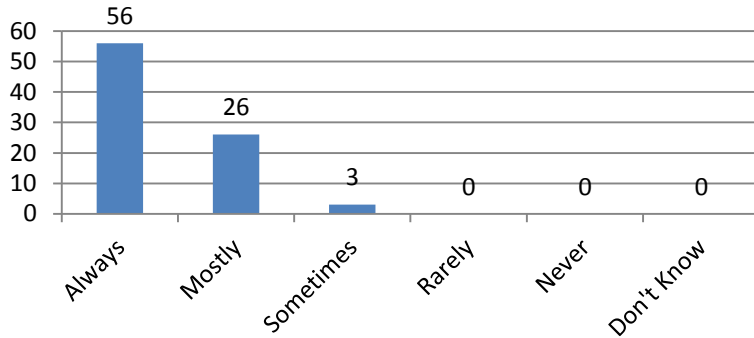

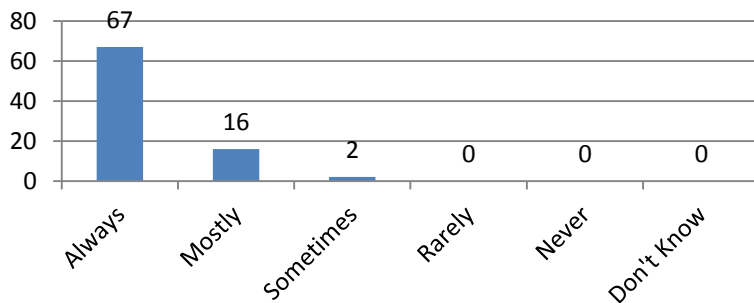
Question 1 - My child(ren) is/are happy at school.

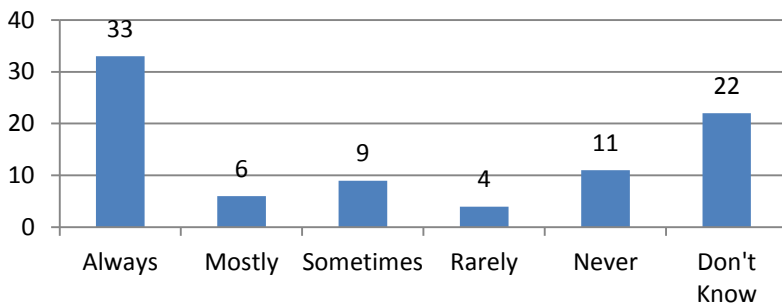
Question 12 - I would like the school to provide more after school clubs.

- My child misses Dodgeball!

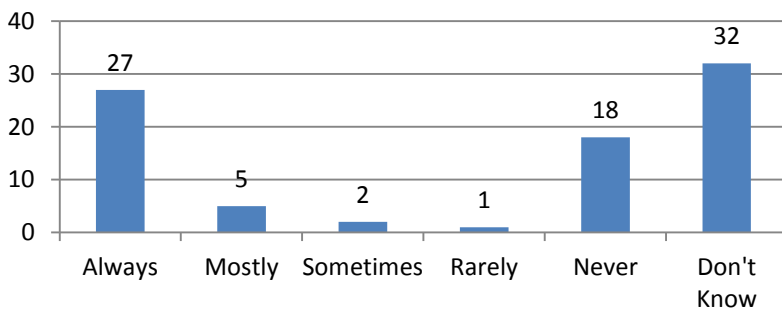
Question 13 - I would send my child to breakfast club if it was free of charge.

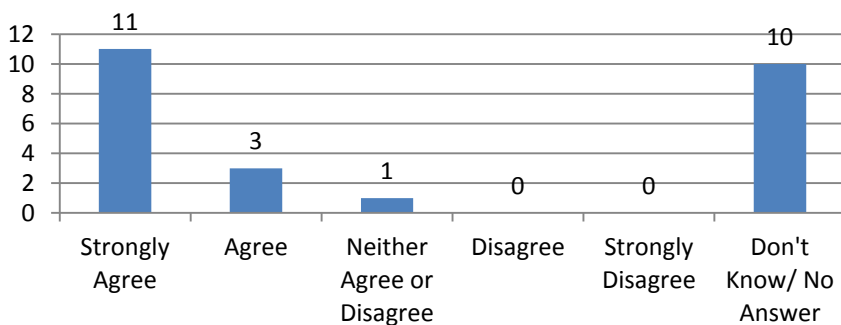

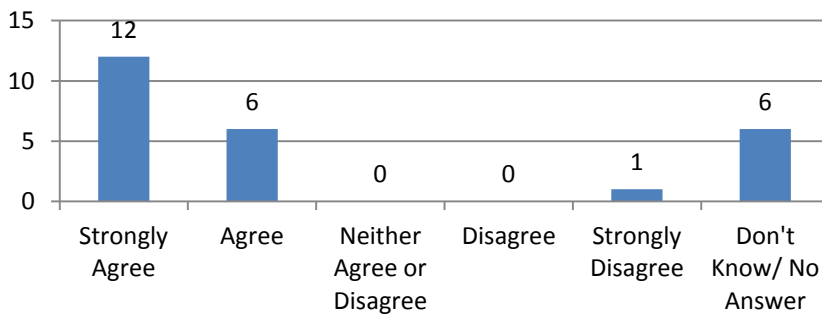

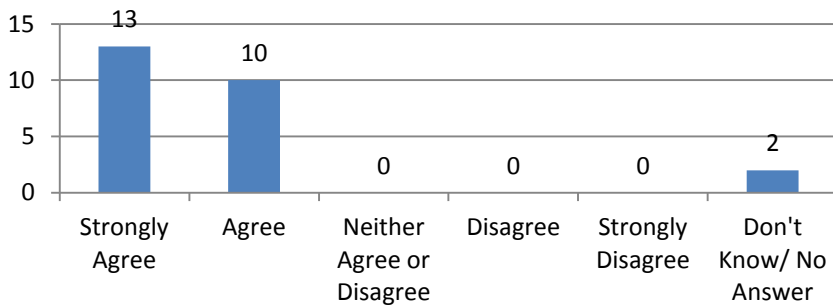

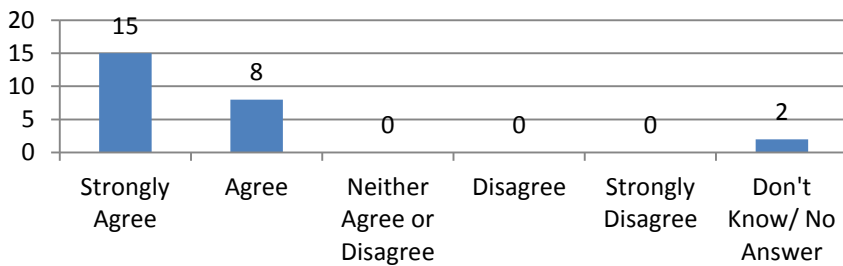
